Are you a high school student who loves our CCYP programs, but wants more of a challenge? Our new Troupe program is made for you! Over the course of a year, the group will be immersed in a wide variety of dramatic material-- everything from classical plays to 10-minute one acts, from comedies to tragedies and farce to melodrama. We will work on a wide variety of performance skills and techniques and the technical and design skills to work backstage. There will be several opportunities to perform throughout the year in a variety of venues.

Troupe meets on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of each month from 6-9 PM, with additional rehearsals scheduled on an as-needed basis. **Troupe is designed to be a flexible program that accommodates the busy schedule of the typical high school student.** Attend as many meetings as you can. The more meetings you attend, the more drama you will do, but you **WILL NOT BE PENALIZED FOR MISSING LESS THAN 50% OF MEETINGS.** All Troupe members are required to attend at least 50% of the meetings over the course of the year. Tuition is \$300 for the year, payable in two \$150 installments (September & January). A discounted tuition of \$275 is available if paid entirely in September.
