



CURTAIN CALL YOUTH PLAYERS ATTENDANCE POLICY

January 2007

On-time attendance at practices and performances is very important. A successful performance depends on the teamwork that develops through practice. Performers depend upon one another to know their lines, entrances, and the role that they are assuming. When a performer misses *any* practice, part of that team is missing. Imagine playing baseball without a third baseman. Rehearsals cannot start until all performers are available. To stress the importance of attendance at all practices and performances, the following policy has been established:

NO more than TWO absences, other than illness or family emergency.

NO absences are allowed on a mandatory date

**NO absences are allowed after the director's call date
(approximately 2 weeks prior to opening).**

Performers are required to be on-time (5 minutes prior to start time)

Students that violate the attendance policy by having more than two absences, missing a mandatory date, or by repetitive tardiness will be reviewed on a case by case basis by the CCYP Board of Directors. If the board determines it to be appropriate, **dismissal from this production or future productions will result and any tuition fees forfeited.**
